Invention Sourcing

Work with CSU's sponsored research office and Tech Transfer staff to gather data to identify CSU faculty working with grants, review information regarding the latest successful grants, as well grants that are closing. Provide curated information to Tech Transfer staff for outreach purposes and help generate new invention disclosures. Work with the Tech Transfer team, cultivate relationships with CSU grantees, inventors, and other potential partners.

Marketing

Review market reports and database information for various innovations and contact companies as potential licensing partners. Input data in the CRM system; track all communication and status of outreach.

Communication

Connect and communicate with Tech Transfer staff and clients. Meet weekly with the supervisor to review and provide updates on progress. Ensure communication with new contacts is detailed and tracked. Work with the Licensing Team on intellectual property, licensing, and business development to increase throughput and cultivate relationships with innovators in the CSU system and external partners/licensees; additional work with the licensing team includes reviewing market and database reports, suggesting company outreach and cultivating opportunities for partnerships. Attend team meetings as able.
